Since 1964 it has been designing, organising and promoting spaces for communication: exhibition stands and shows, stores, art exhibitions, concerts, conferences, meetings, fashion shows, multimedia shows and international sporting events. Today the Group can depend on a staff of more than 200 professionals working in more than 20 countries around the world. In 1996, it designed Futurshow, the exhibition of technological innovation, which attracted the attention of all sector experts for eight years and which saw Bill Gates open the final edition. In 2003, the Group saved Virtus, Bologna's historic basketball team, and has been running it ever since. In 2008, it acquired, and has been running ever since, the Casalecchio di Reno indoor sports stadium (maximum capacity of more than 14,000), now the Unipol Arena, and transformed it into the largest theatre in Italy; in November 2011 it hosted the first date of the European leg of Paul McCartney's concert tour.
